

Shop Trustee Eligibility

The Charities Act 2005 requires that all people acting as a trustee meet the qualifying criteria under the Act. I therefore ask that you read the information below and confirm your eligibility by signing at the bottom of the form.

Criteria for Trustees (Charities Act 2005 Clause 16(2))

The following persons are disqualified from being officers of charitable entities:

- an individual who is an undischarged bankrupt
- an individual who is under the age of 16 years
- an individual who, or a body corporate that, has been convicted of a crime involving dishonesty (within the meaning of section 2(1) of the Crimes Act 1961) or tax evasion or a similar offence under section 143B of the Tax Administration Act 1994 and sentenced for that offence within the last seven years.
- an individual who is prohibited from being a director or promoter of, or being concerned or taking part in the management of, a company under section 382, section 383, or section 385 of the Companies Act 1993
- an individual who, or a body corporate that, is disqualified from being an officer of a charitable entity under section 31(4)
- f. an individual who is subject to a property order made under the Protection of Personal and Property Rights Act 1988, or whose property is managed by a trustee corporation under section 32 of that Act
- a body corporate that is being wound up, is in liquidation or receivership, or is subject to statutory management under the Corporations (Investigation and Management) Act 1989
- in relation to any particular entity, an individual who, or a body corporate that, does not comply with any qualifications for officers contained in the rules of that entity
